## NEW COMMUNITY CRÈCHE

Families, educators, and community leaders joined hands with the Department of Education to celebrate the reopening of the Tshwaraganang Early Childhood Development (ECD) Centre in Hertzogville, Free State. The center now offers care and education to over 70 children.

The renovation includes four new classrooms, a modernized kitchen, storage, an ablution block, fencing, outdoor play equipment, and a food garden. This marks the fifth ECD refurb, supported by Boshof Solar Power, benefiting Boshof and Hertzogville communities.
