STRENGTHENING ECD IN GREYTON



The renovation of Vrolike Vinkies Daycare Centre in Greyton has improved the learning environment for 32 children, making the Centre safer, compliant with educational standards, and eligible for government funding.

The renovation addressed several infrastructure and maintenance issues, further benefitting the broader Greyton community as local builders and subcontractors we employed, creating five additional jobs.
